The past four years has witnessed world-wide commemorations of the First World War – the intensity and poignancy of these commemorations have varied as we have recalled and reflected on the “War to end all Wars”. Commemoration was, I am sure, the right word to use during these remembrances and even when we gather on Armistice Day celebrations will be muted as we acknowledge the Depression and the unrest and uncertainty which followed the Great War quickly leading to the outbreak of the Second.

On **Remembrance Sunday** there will be opportunities to remember and rededicate ourselves to justice and peace: Northumbrian Pipes before the 8.00am Eucharist; muffled bells ringing before 9.30 am; acts of remembrance and commitment at the 9.30 Eucharist; two minutes silence at 11.00 by the WW1 memorial inside church; our bells ringing with church bells nationwide from 12.30; a Cry for Peace outside the RBL Club at 7.05pm.

In all these commemorations we invoke the mercy and inspiration of the Prince of Peace whose birth we prepare for during Advent and celebrate at Christmas:

May the memory of wars strengthen our efforts for peace;
May the memory of those who died inspire our service to the living;
May the memory of past destruction move us to build for the future;
O Prince of Peace, O builder of Love and Justice in the world,
Hear our prayer. (Anglican Pacifist Fellowship 2018, slightly amended)
