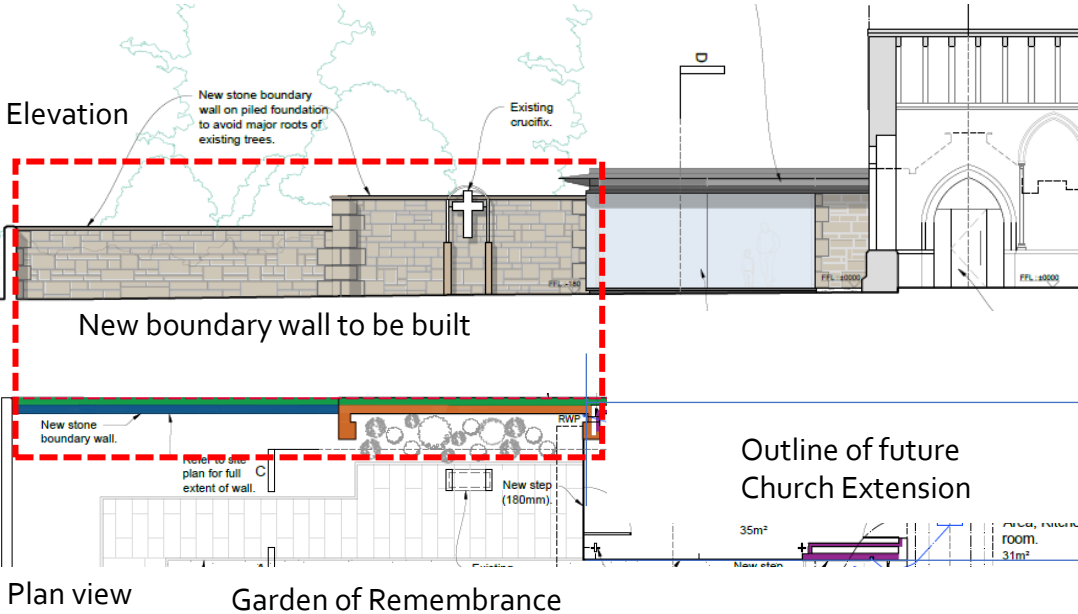


# Church Extension Update

The planning approval we have for the church extension requires us to start work by the end of this month. The PCC has discussed and approved the construction of a new sandstone boundary wall to the rear of the Garden of Remembrance (shown in the elevation and plan, below) which forms part of the approved planning drawings. This is independent of the church extension and will significantly enhance the Garden of Remembrance.

Over the next few weeks you will notice the old broken fencing at the rear of the Garden of Remembrance being taken down and seven trees being removed as identified in the approved tree management plan. Then a piling rig will insert a row of piles along the length of the wall and a trench will be dug and infilled with concrete to form the foundation of the new wall. This is the first stage and we then intend to continue with the construction of the wall as soon as we are able to. There may be a period during which we have temporary 'Heras fencing' in place to secure the boundary. All access will be from the rear (Tennis Club) side and no people, machinery or equipment will stray onto the Garden of Remembrance.
